1. Why are you seeking your office?

I have traveling around this State.

I want to return public service to the office of Lt. Governor. The Lt. Governor is also the President of the Senate, the highest legislative office *elected statewide*, *by the people of Georgia* (not by peers). The Lt. Governor has considerable influence over policy. I will ensure that bills coming out of the Senate preserve freedom and enhance quality of life in Georgia. 2. What do you expect to accomplish if elected?

I'll support improvements to further secure our election process. And I'll advocate for Georgia to eliminate state income tax and replace it with the Georgia Fair Tax Act.

3. What distinguishes your candidacy?

I bring a woman's perspective to the mix. I don't run on that, but I do think it is an asset. As a mother, grandmother, and child advocate I've been engaged in policy making from the grassroots level for many years. I am an outsider to the political establishment, yet I understand the process and what is needed to bring government back to the people. I am the only candidate fighting to keep the predatory gambling industry out of Georgia.

4. Pick any one issue. Expand on how you will address it.

Predatory gambling is an industry that only succeeds when its consumers lose. Gambling expansion would change Georgia forever and also targets our children. Out-of-state gambling promoters are gaining influence with powerful legislators - two of whom are my opponents in this race.

I don't want to see the people of Georgia - and our quality of life - become casualties of these

predatory industries. I will work to educate the people of Georgia and our legislators about the negative impact of gambling to prevent support for it in Georgia communities, or at the Capitol. I'll keep gambling expansion from reaching (100)

5. What are your ideas on curbing all the many area-wide shooting?

The way we can prevent crime and shootings is for Georgia to focus on prevention of our youth in their early years. Seaver has been a child advocate for over 20 years and very familiar with Juvenile crime. When children stop coming to school (Truant), even as early as elementary school, middle that is the first sign they are going off track, we need to find out why they are not in school and work hard to get them back on track. Although she has never been about a hand out but a hand up!
