# 1. Why are you seeking office?

I am honored to be the Democratic nominee for the United States House of Representatives from Georgia's 6th district. A mob, driven by a President incapable of believing he had lost and tacitly encouraged by the Republican Party attacked the United States Capitol.

## 2. What do you expect to accomplish if elected?

I will immediately seek a seat on both the House Committee of Veterans Affairs and the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure as I believe these are issues that resonate across the entire 6<sup>th</sup> district. I will work tirelessly to codify Roe V. Wade as the law of the land to ensure women have equal rights at the national level. # 3. What distinguishes your candidacy?

#### 4. Pick any one issue. Expand on how you will address the issue.

I believe in stopping the proliferation of assault weapons on our streets by renewing the ban on their sale. All three of these proposals are supported by the majority of Americans. It is time to bring that voice to Washington.

I served my country in the United States Army for ten years. I spent one year in Iraq, where I witnessed the full impact of American policy on foreign nations and US service members. I transitioned to civilian service in the restaurant industry, working my way from the kitchen to the board room over a 17 year career. Upon retirement, I became a sports reporter for the Dawson County News, but that ended with Covid. Today, I run a home-based bakery with my wife and have dedicated myself to bringing a regular everyday voice to the U.S. Congress.
